Pinnacle 100 Bootloader

Version 3.0

Release notes are a summary of new and enhanced features, resolved issues, and known issues that are not resolved in this firmware version. This release note describes the changes and enhancements to the firmware of the Pinnacle 100 Bootloader in reverse chronological order.

For each version (excluding the initial version) there are subsections for New Features, Bug Fixes, and Known Issues.

Pinnacle 100 bootloader firmware version numbers consist of six sets of one number each in the format described below. This number can be read back from the module by submitting the command M when it is in bootloader mode.

- **Model** – Signifies the module ID. In the case of the Pinnacle 100, this number is *124*.
 - **Variant** – Signifies the variant. This number is *0* for standard modules.
 - **Name** – Signifies the module name in text form. In the case of the Pinnacle 100, this number is *PINNACLE100*.
 - **Bootloader version** – Signifies the release version (i.e., the major build number).
 - **FUP** – Signifies the bootloader protocol version. So far, the values are as follows:

6.010	Test release
6.011	Initial production release
 - **Ext. struct** – Signifies the version of the structure used to query bootloader information. So far, the values are as follows:

1	Initial release

 - **Ext. function** – Signifies the version of the bootloader information function code. So far, the values are as follows:
